






## Drawing composition

Example of drawings composition created using imaginary boxes. A step by step process will be demonstrate in the next sections of this book.







## A basket


**Tips:** Practice to draw straight lines with confident






## A stool


This exercise is to show the process of drawing a stool's components one by one to create a composition. The process started by drawing the upper component then continue with the other parts.



**Tips**: Always remember to draw imaginary box.









## A glass


The process shows how to draw a glass composition using an imaginary box as the main guidance to complete the drawing.






## A sofa
